Subject: Minutes of the meeting of 2nd Medical Committee Meeting under Ayushman Bharat PMJAY/SEHAT

2nd Medical Committee meeting under Ayushman Bharat PMJAY & AB PM-JAY SEHAT was held on 26th June, 2021 through the virtual mode, under the chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer, State Health Agency J&K. Following officers/officials participated in the meeting:

Decisions:

Following decisions were taken by the Medical Committee:

Procedure	Cost as per Hospital	Decisions Taken
(PCI-LAD) IVUS	2 Lakhs	The committee was with the opinion that the PCI-LAD with IVUS is a dynamic procedure hence cost may be decided on the basis of number of stents required and cost of IVUS need to be separately added which will be Rs. 40,000. The case was approved by the committee; however, the hospital needs to provide detailed cost breakup to SHA J&K after performing the procedure.
COA STENTING	4 Lakhs	The committee was with the opinion that as per HBP 2.0 only Balloon Dilatation is covered for the correction of Coarctation of Aorta and not the stenting. The procedure was approved at same rates as proposed by the hospital.
Coiling for Right MCA Bifurcation Aneurysm	4 Lakhs	The committee suggested that cost of per coil is around Rs. 50,000 to 60,000 and final cost of the procedure may be decided accordingly. The procedure was approved but hospital was requested to provide detailed cost break up of this procedure.
CRT D	4.90 Lakhs	The Committee decided to fix and approve the cost of CRT-D procedure at Rs. 4.90 lakhs as per CGHS

Agenda 2: Cost fixation of CRT-P and ICD (Single Chamber) Packages

A threadbare discussion was held regarding the need of fixing the cost of CRT-P and ICD (Single Chamber) Packages. The chair was informed that different tertiary care hospitals have quoted different rates for CRT-P and ICD Single Chamber. It was briefed to the committee that following analysis has been done while evaluating the rates of these packages.

Decisions:

Following are the decisions taken by the hospital:

- Rate of CRT-P was fixed at same rates as quoted by SKIMS i.e Rs. 2.80 Lakhs
- Rate of ICD Single Chamber was fixed at same rates as quoted by SKIMS i.e Rs. 2.50 Lakhs.

Agenda 3: Addition of CRT-P, CRT-D and AICD packages in HBP 2.0

The chair was informed that that CRT-P, CRT-D and AICD are frequently booked unspecified packages in some public tertiary care hospitals for which Patient has to wait for getting the package approved in the Medical Committee. It was also briefed as per guidelines issued by NHA that if an unspecified package is booked more frequently, then SHA will add the same and make it as specified package in HBP.

Decision:

The committee decided to take up the matter with NHA for adding these procedures in HBP 2.0 for J&K.

Agenda 4: Other unspecified packages

It was informed that some unspecified packages like Retrograde Intrarenal Surgery (RIRS), sinus dilatation, hemi-arthroplasty- Modular bipolar Cementless, Shoulder orthoscopy, upper limb single bone nail/plate, Cannulated Screw Fixation of neck of femur, Fracture distal end of radius, spine instrumentation etc costs is less than Rs. 1 Lakhs and same packages were booked by some hospitals but claim was not settled as per the cost proposed by the hospitals.

Decisions:

Following decisions were taken up by the Medical Committee:

- a. The cost of RIRS unilateral was fixed at Rs. 60,000 for both all the EHCPs in in UT of J&K.
- b. HoD Orthopedics Bone and Joint Hospital Srinagar and HoD Orthopedics GMC Jammu will provide the tentative cost of above-mentioned orthopedic packages for final approval by the Chairman of the Medical Committee.

Agenda 5: Centralized rate contracting for supplying of implants

It was briefed to the chair that implants for same procedure are being provided by supplier on different rates to different hospitals within the UT of J&K. This rate difference ultimately effects the overall packages rates and ultimately the actual cost of these packages exceeds the package rates as specified in HBP of NHA. In order to chain the market, several States Like Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Telangana etc have come up with a mechanism of centralized rate contracting of implants. In the name same analogy SHA J&K intends to do centralized rate contracting and vendor(s) will be selected for supplying implants to hospitals.

Decision:

The committee members/HoDs of concerned specialities were requested to provide the specifications like Model, Made, Type of these implants to SHA J&K within 10 days.
